A Busy Spring!

As we reopen on February 3, following a time of cleaning and general upkeep work during January, we find ourselves looking ahead to a busy spring. In February we will host an exhibit of Knights of Columbus memorabilia on loan from **K of C Council No. 3078**, with a public reception set for Saturday, February 20th at 2:00 p.m. here at the museum (see adjacent article).

Our First Wednesday evening programs of 2016 will kick off on Wednesday, March 2nd with Lincoln Park librarian **Nicole Kessler** giving an overview of the history of the LP Library. The program begins at 7:00 P.M.

The Wednesday, April 6th program will feature guest speaker Vinnie Bruzzese, Administrator for the Lincoln Park chapter of the Loyal Order of the Moose 1665. Mr. Bruzzese will talk about the history of the Moose organization and the chapter's current activities. The program will begin at 7:00 P.M.

April will also see our first fundraiser dinner in many years. We are looking to raise funds to pay for the repairs, including replacement parts and installation for the Verdin Street Clock which has been inoperable since last spring. A company inspection showed that the motor, gears and bearings needed replacing. Our annual giving campaign this past fall was helpful in raising over one thousand dollars toward the work that needs to be done, but we still need to raise four thousand dollars - the total cost is \$5,800. This will see not simply a replacement of mechanical parts but an upgrade to the clock mechanism and its computer that will be guaranteed for 3 years. The clock was originally purchased in 2002 for about \$24,000.

The dinner will be held on Saturday, April 16th at the Loyal Order of Moose 1665 hall located at 1600 Fort Street, from 2:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. (see article for more information incl. tickets.)

"Knights of Columbus, Robert H. Jones Council 3078" to be feted on February 20

Knights of Columbus Robert H. Jones Council No. 3078 will be featured in a 2:00 p.m. program held at the museum on Saturday, February 20th. Council member Jim Salliotte will speak on the history of Council 3078 which was chartered in Lincoln Park in

1947. The council was named in honor of first Grand Master Robert H. Jones following his passing in 1950. Members of Mr. Jones' family have been invited to attend. An exhibit of Knights of



Columbus memorabilia is on display at the museum through February.

HERITAGE PLAZA UPDATE

The Heritage Plaza project began last spring as we kicked off the celebration of the City of Lincoln Park's 90th anniversary. Orders for the brick pavers for the plaza continue to be accepted. All orders received since last September will be included in a dedication scheduled for Saturday May 14th at 12 noon. The order deadline for inclusion in this third installation is Wednesday, March 30th. The cost of the engraved pavers remains the same: \$100 for a 4"x8" paver with three lines of text, or \$150 for an 8"x8" with six lines of text. Payment should be included with the order form. Forms are available at the Museum, at City Hall and at the Library. All funds raised beyond the engraving and installation costs will go toward the Historical Museum's continuing operations.
